Audition Notice

Dance Victoria is hosting a choreographic lab July 17 through 29, 2017 at its studios on Quadra Street. Led by Artistic Director Wen Wei Wang, the lab will bring together three emerging choreographers and a company of six pre-professional dancers and two apprentices.

The dancer's commitment is full-time over the two weeks. Each day will start at 9:30 am with a 1.5 hr technique class led by Wen Wei. After class, each choreographer will be assigned a task. The dancers, apprentices and choreographers will retreat to one of the three studios at Dance Victoria to develop material based on the task. At the end of the day, each choreographer will share their work and engage in a discussion about the work.

- Must be at a pre-professional level with at least three years of advanced training in contemporary/contemporary ballet

About Wen Wei Wang

Wen Wei Wang began dancing at an early age in China, where he was born and raised. He trained and danced professionally with the Langzhou Song and Dance Company. In 1991, he came to Canada and joined the Judith Marcuse Dance Company after which he danced with Ballet British Columbia for seven years. Since 2003, he has served as Artistic Director of Wen Wei Dance. Wen Wei is the recipient of many awards such as the 2000 Clifford E. Lee Choreographic Award and the 2006 Isadora Award for Excellence in Choreography (*Unbound*). In addition to his works for Wen Wei Dance, he has choreographed for the Alberta Ballet, Ballets Jazz de Montréal, Ballet Jorgen, Dancers Dancing, North West Dance Projects (Portland), Vancouver and San Francisco Opera's production of *Nixon in China*. His works have toured across Canada, the US, China. Wen Wei Dance has been a featured company at the Venice Biennale. In December 2016, Wen Wei served as movement coach for the National Theatre of China's (Beijing) production of Hamlet.
