A Canadian Premiere! Ballet Hispánico's *Doña Perón* Offers Intriguing Glimpse into the Life of Eva "Evita" Perón

Royal Theatre, April 8 + 9, 2022, 7:30 pm

VICTORIA, B.C. – <u>Ballet Hispánico</u>, New York's premier Latinx dance organization, brings the Canadian premiere of *Doña Perón*, a new full-length contemporary ballet to the Royal Theatre on April 8 and 9, 2022. Tickets start at \$29 and are on sale now at <u>DanceVictoria.com</u>.

Doña Perón celebrates one of the most spellbinding women in South American history. Eva "Evita" Perón rose from dancehall performer to First Lady of Argentina before her untimely death at 33 years old. She became powerful within the pro-Peronist trade unions, primarily for speaking on behalf of labour rights. Perón also ran the Ministries of Labour and Health, founded the charitable Eva Perón Foundation, championed women's suffrage in Argentina, and ran the nation's first large-scale Female Peronist Party. She has become a part of international popular culture, most famously as the subject of the musical Evita (1976) and later the movie (1996) starring Madonna. Ballet Hispánico's contemporary ballet takes an empowering view into the little-known aspects of her personal life that shaped her into such a beloved public figure.

Starting from Evita's fear of sleeping alone, the ballet weaves episodes of her life into a collection of moving snapshots that piece together an extraordinary new picture of her as a leader and agent of change. Sumptuous, surprising, and instantly popular—like Evita herself— *Doña Perón* is choreographed by Belgian-Colombian **Annabelle Lopez Ochoa**, the internationally-renowned creator of the Scottish Ballet's *A Streetcar Named Desire* which received the Critics' Circle National Dance Award for "Best Classical Choreography" and was nominated for the prestigious Olivier Award for Best New Dance Production the following year. Set to music by the ballet composer Peter Salem, *Doña Perón* will make its world premiere in the U.S. just prior to its Canadian premiere in Victoria as part of the Company's national tour.
