Expressions of Interest for *Chrystal Dance Prize - Projects*Now Open

VICTORIA, B.C. – Western Canada's richest dance prize for international collaboration, the <u>Chrystal Dance Prize - Projects</u>, is accepting expressions of interest from dance artists, companies and collectives for 2023/24. The <u>Chrystal Dance Prize - Projects</u> supports exceptional dance research and/or creation between a Western Canadian dance artist, collectives or companies and an international dance artist(s), interpreter, or choreographer. Dance Victoria will award \$56,000 in the <u>Chrystal Dance Prize - Projects</u> category. The prize money may be allocated across multiple projects or can be awarded for a single project.

Fast Facts About the Chrystal Dance Prize - Projects

- Expressions of interest are accepted from September 15 until October 14, 2023, at 5:00 p.m. Pacific Time.
- The *Chrystal Dance Prize* is generated from a bequest made by Dance Victoria patron, Dr. Betty "Chrystal" Kleiman, to the Victoria Foundation.
- Dance artists, companies and/or collectives applying for the prize must live or be headquartered in Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta, British Columbia, Yukon or Northwest Territories.
- The prize supports collaborative projects that involve a Canadian artist(s) working with another dance artist (choreographer or interpreter) outside of Canada.
- The prize is open to any dance artist that is active in the professional dance milieu,
 has worked with a range of dance artists or companies and has a history of dance
 creation, and is applying as an independent dance artist or member of a small
 collective or established dance company. Companies and collectives submitting
 proposals must also have a body of work and a history of commissioning work.
- A committee of dance professionals is assembled each year to select the recipients.
- The prize recipient(s) may also have the opportunity for a two-week residency at Dance Victoria Studios.

PLEASE NOTE: The **Chrystal Dance Prize – Projects** panel consists of Dance Victoria's Executive Director (ED), one Board member, and two independent and external community members. In our small Victoria dance community, it is reasonable that an applicant will be connected to Dance Victoria as a staff member, studio access or artist residency participant, or similar. The panel will accept these applications and review them with equal criteria. In the case of a staff member or other direct conflict of interest, the ED will not score the application and only the external panel members scores will be considered.

The panel may elect not to award a prize in a given year if the projects submitted are not considered exceptional or ready for support. If the panel does not support any projects in a given year, the *Chrystal Dance Prize* funds will be re-invested for allocation in future years.

Applications for the *Chrystal Dance Prize – Training* for emerging dance artists completing their training at recognized international dance institutions will open in March 2023 on DanceVictoria.com.
