# Compagnie Hervé KOUBI Brings Spellbinding Contemporary Dance to the Royal Theatre!

February 2 + 3, 2024

VICTORIA, B.C. – Dance Victoria brings "a touch of theatrical magic" (*The New York Times*) to the Royal Theatre with <u>Compagnie Hervé KOUBI</u> (France/Algeria) in *The Barbarian Nights (or The First Dawns of the World)* on February 2 and 3, 2024 at 7:30 p.m.

*The Barbarian Nights* is the sequel of Compagnie Hervé KOUBI's seminal work, *What the Day Owes to the Night*, which astounded Dance Victoria audiences as a virtual presentation during the pandemic. The company's long-awaited Royal Theatre debut showcases thirteen male street dancers from Algeria, Morocco, France, and Burkina Faso. Dressed in Swarovski crystal-inspired headgear, dancers whirl around the stage in outbursts of cartwheels, somersaults, back flips and head spins against a musical backdrop of Mozart, Fauré and traditional Algerian melodies.

*The Barbarian Nights* takes a sensitive look at the history of the Mediterranean basin, where the mixture of cultures, religions and the sacred reveals the foundations of a common geography on which, according to artistic director and choreographer Hervé Koubi, "we are standing too often without knowing." Koubi's interest in one's origins is personal. When he was 25, his father broke the news that Hervé and his mother were not native French, but Algerian, a designation that for more than a century equated to being a second-class citizen in France. *The Barbarian Nights* investigates ancestral fear of strangers and the innate desire to resist people who are different. Koubi explains, "I use dance to develop the relationship we have with the unknown, with the so-called Barbarians. What I seek is not a rehabilitation of history towards these peoples, but to bring a more sensitive light, filled with humanity."

On a quest to assemble the perfect cast of dancers, Koubi traveled to North Africa and auditioned more than 250 people for his company, ultimately selecting 13 men with street dance backgrounds mostly in hip-hop and specialized acrobatics. Mixing their dance skills with his contemporary style, Koubi creates a one-of-a-kind, ritualistic performance that explodes with athleticism, verve, and irresistible, raw force. As part of Dance Victoria's Community Engagement programs, Compagnie Hervé KOUBI will lead a free masterclass for local students during their time in Victoria.

#### About Compagnie Hervé KOUBI

Of Algerian descent, Hervé Koubi grew up in France where he studied biology and dance at the University of Aix-en-Provence before graduating as a Pharmaceutical Doctor in 2002. Deciding to concentrate on a dancing career, he graduated from the Rosella Hightower School of Dance in Cannes, gaining experience as a dancer and creating his first project *Le Golem*. He formed his own company in 2010, working with male street dancers from North Africa on several works including *What the Day Owes to The Night, The Barbarian Nights (or The First Dawns of the World),* and *Boys Don't Cry*. Hervé Koubi was Associate Choreographer at the Pole National Supérieur de Danse in France and received the Chevalier des Arts et des Lettres in 2015.
